

# an talla solais Open Access Community Art Room

The Community Art Room is available for individual and group bookings throughout most of the year. During some periods it will be set aside for use by a visiting Artist in Residence.

In addition, ATS's Room 3 is available for some weeks in March and October for group workshop use.

## Facilities

The Community Art Room measures 3.4m x 4.4m and includes a sink with cold running water. Tables and chairs are available for use: suggested 6 adults seated comfortably at tables or using easels, or 8 people with less room for manoeuvre. For a talk or discussion group, up to 15 could be seated. There is access to the ATS kitchen for teas and coffees. Please ask to come and see the space if you're not sure it will meet your needs.

Eventually easels, drawing boards, water pots and other items for group use will be available. Artists should bring their own materials (paints etc) and specialist equipment.

## Types of activities

All types of visual arts activity are invited. Whether you would like to run a regular evening class on a commercial basis, do your own artwork in a quiet space, organize a week or weekend course or get together with a group of friends and do something creative, you will be welcome in the art room.

## Room rates

The room can be hired for an evening, a half-day, a day or up to 7 days at once, including a special weekend rate. In exceptional cases the room can be hired for a longer period, and use by artists in residence will be encouraged within reason.

There are two room rates, for standard use (including use of the room on a commercial basis) and community rates. Please see separate sheet for details. We keep the rates deliberately low to make the room as accessible as possible. However if you would like to use the room but still cannot afford to pay, please let us know as a special rate might be possible.

## Dates of availability

Jan to July: open access [Note that Room 3 is also available in March]

August: open access (EXCEPT FOR regular weekly sessions)

Sept: open access

Oct: designated artist-in-residence space [Note that Room 3 is available in October]

Nov to Dec: open access

Please note that we run bookings on a first come, first served policy, and the room will not always be available: please give us plenty of warning if you'd like specific dates.

## Agreement about room use

Users will be asked to abide by ATS's Conditions of Let, undertaking to take responsibility for the space when they hire it. Cleaning materials will be available in the room and users are asked to leave it in the clean state in which they find it.
